1900 census: widowed, aged 54, cook for Emma and Herman Wells (mother and son), 208 Harrison Street

[Herman Dulaney Wells was later secretary-treasurer of J.P. Bell Co. book publishers]

1910 census: widowed, aged 68, private family laundress for Emma and Herman Wells (mother and son), 208 Harrison Street

Mattie [Crews?] Lassiter (death certificate informant) was mulatto wife of Norman Lassiter, prominent dentist in Newport News (Google search for "Norman Lassiter Dental Society")
