Obituary and Biographical Detials

Residence in 1917: Stapleton, Amherst County, Virginia

Death certificate gives occupation as “soldier”

Death certificate informant was Jack Mays of Stapleton, Amherst County, Virginia

1920 census: carpenter, living with wife Martha and son Raymond in household of parents-in-law Thomas and Berta Gunter in Appomattox County (Stonewall District)

1923 LCD: 706 Fifth Street was address of Liggan & Williams (grocers)
