Obituary and Biographical Detials

According to her death certificate, she contracted tuberculosis in Alabama. She was living on the Tuskegee Institute campus in the 1920 census (31 January 1920), working as a teacher in the normal school.

According to Tuskegee University Archives, she was a faculty member from 1919 to 1921.
