Small Shrub Growing 3'-5' Tall by 3' Wide
Thornless or Nearly Thornless, Moderate Fragrance
Drought Resistant and Heat Tolerant



Ballerina Hybrid Musk Rose

Introduced 1937

Pink with White Center, Single Blooms

Blooms in Flushes Throughout the Season

Mild Fragrance, Shade Tolerant

Smaller Shrub Growing 3'-6' Tall by 3'-5' Wide

Can Be Used in Containers

Hybrid Setigera

Introduced 1843

Delicate Clusters of Pale Pink Bloom
Blooms Late, But for a Long Time
Healthy Foliage, Hardy
Very Disease Resistant
Will Mound and Cascade with Support

Pink, lilac shading
Strong fragrance
Average diameter 6"
Spring or summer flush with scattered later
bloom

Introduced 1894

Large Pale Pink, Double Blooms-Repeats
Medium Size Shrub
Beautiful Large Orange-Red Hips
Rugosas <u>Do Not</u> Like To Be Sprayed



Borderer Polyantha Rose

Introduced 1918

Pink with Salmon, Full Fragrant Blooms
Small Compact Shrub Habit
Good for Container & Beds
Very Disease Resistant
Remove Spent Blooms to Encourage Re-Bloom



Cascading Swamp Rose

Rosa palustris scandens

Species Rose

Introduced Before 1824

Bright Pink, Double Blooms
Very Late Bloomer
Tall Arching Canes
Beside the Cemetery's Lotus Pond



Chestnut Rose

Rosa roxburghii

Species Rose

Introduced Before 1814

Bright Pink, Double "Carnation" Blooms
Older Stems Have Peeling Bark
Fluffy Foliage, Thorny Buds, Very Unusual & Tough

Introduced 1946

Profuse, Medium-Pink, Double Flowers
Mild Fragrance, Repeat Bloomer
Hardy & Disease Resistant
Excellent Container Rose or Low Hedge

Light Pink, Semi-Double Blooms
Light Fragrance
Spring Bloomer with Little to No Thorns
Mannerly Climber 8-12' or Cascading Shrub
5-7'

Thorny, Disease-Resistant
Along Wall in Pest House Garden

Introduced 1950

Pink to Lavender Blooms
Shade Tolerant, Medium Shrub Size (4'-6')
Mild to Strong Clove Fragrance
Does not Like Much Pruning, Prickles on Canes
Along Wall in Pest House Garden
