



# Barbara's Pasture Rose

Pink, violet undertones

Mild to strong fragrance

Average diameter 5"

Large, cupped, flat, ruffled bloom form

Blooms in flushes throughout the season



# Cardinal de Richelieu

Mauve or purple blend

Introduced before 1847

None to mild fragrance

Once-blooming spring or summer



# Rugosa Hansa

*Hybrid Rugosa Rose*

Introduced 1905

Purple, Large, Double Blooms

Spring or Summer Blooming with Occasional Repeat

Medium to Large Shrub Growing 5'-7' Tall by 4'-7' Wide

Strong Clove Fragrance, Drought and Disease Resistant

Produces Decorative Hips



## Sweet Pea

*Polyantha Rose*

Introduced 1996

Purple and Mauve, Small, Clustered, Double Blooms

Continuous Bloom Throughout the Season

Small Shrub Growing 2'-3'

Moderate Fragrance

Great for Containers



# Veilchenblau

## **Hybrid Multiflora Rose**

Introduced Before 1909

Deep Lavender with Yellow Centers

Clusters of Small Blooms

Manageable Climber or Graceful Shrub

Nearly Thornless, Very Fragrant
