Hybrid Wichurana Rose

Introduced 1900

Light yellow ages to white
Climbing, thornless, soft canes
Moderate, green apple, tea fragrance
Shade tolerant, almost evergreen
Can be trained on pillars, swags, and lattice

"Yellow Lady Banks"

Species Rose

Introduced 1824

Large Clusters of Small, Pale Yellow Blooms
Lacy Foliage
Vigorous Climber—Needs Support
Very Few Thorns



Gardenia Hybrid Wichurana Rose

Introduced 1899

Medium-size Pale Yellow Blooms
Vigorous but Graceful Habit
Needs Something to Grow on!
Healthy, Glossy, Dark Green Foliage



Ghislaine de Feligonde

Hybrid Multiflora Rose

Introduced 1916

Distinctive Pale Yellow Color
Large Clusters of Double Blooms
Blooms Once, Disease Resistant
Climber up to 20 Feet, Nearly Thornless



Mermaid Hybrid Bracteata Rose

Introduced 1918

Huge Yellow Flowers, Showy Stamens Huge Climber—Up to 20 Feet! Continuous Blooms, Starting "Late" Very Tough, Disease Free, Big Thorns



Mrs. Dudley Cross Tea Rose

Introduced 1908

Light Yellow with Pink Highlights, Double Blooms

Blooms in Flushes Throughout the Season

Medium to Large Shrub Growing 3'-10' Tall by 3'-10'

Wide

Moderate Fragrance, Thornless or Nearly Thornless
